On the **Puppy Course** your puppy will socialise with the others and be introduced to obedience training. This includes puppy recall and recall to a whistle, sit, down, stay and walking to heel. Each week covers a puppy related topic i.e. house training, grooming etc. There is a question/answer slot at the beginning of each class. Titbits to motivate your puppy will generally be used, they would make a percentage of his daily food intake. These titbits will be gradually lessened as the weeks go by and your puppy is achieving each exercise. At the end of your eight weeks you can join a Beginners class which is a natural progression.

Beginners includes extended sit stay, down stay, heelwork and recall, giving up an article on command, doorway manners, meet and greet, bodily examination and car management. Please note: due to waiting list numbers, beginners classes are limited to you and your dog attending two sets of eight weeks. However, during this time you may be ready to progress up to the Intermediate level, in which case Ruth will move you up as and when.

Intermediate includes extended exercises as above, also formal present and finish on recall, 'A' recall, food refusal, off lead heelwork and distance control. If there is a waiting list, Intermediate classes will be limited to you and your dog attending two sets of eight weeks.
